

Ministerial Decision No. 56 of 2026

Amending certain provisions of Ministerial Decision No. 64 of 2025 on the eligibility criteria and Accreditation procedure for Service Providers under the Electronic Invoicing System

Having reviewed the following

- The Constitution,
- Federal Law No. 1 of 1972 on the Competencies of Ministries and Powers of the Ministers, and its amendments,
- Ministerial Decision No. 64 of 2025 on the eligibility criteria and Accreditation procedure for Service Providers under the Electronic Invoicing System,

Minister of State for Financial Affairs has decided:

Article One

The text of Article 5 of Ministerial Decision No. 64 of 2025 shall be replaced by the following text:

Article 5 – Eligibility Criteria for Obtaining Accreditation

1. A Service Provider applying for Accreditation must fulfil all of the following conditions:
 - a) Is an active Peppol-certified Service Provider who has successfully completed the OpenPeppol conformance tests.
 - b) Meet the experience requirements under Article 5(bis) of this Decision.
 - c) Fulfil the company registration conditions under Article 6 of this Decision.
 - d) Adhere to the Service Provider requirements under Article 7 of this Decision.
 - e) Meet the tax registration obligations under Article 8 of this Decision.
 - f) Comply with the PSP Product information security requirements under Article 9 of this Decision.
 - g) Meet the self-declaration condition under Article 10 of this Decision.
 - h) Meet the insurance requirements under Article 11 of this Decision.
2. A Service Provider may utilise a PSP Product that is owned by a third party, and may outsource the development, operation, or management of the PSP Product or any element of its Electronic Invoicing Services to a third party, provided that the Service Provider retains full responsibility for meeting the conditions referred to in Clause 1 of this Article, and for the oversight over the provision of the Electronic Invoicing Services in accordance with this Decision.
3. Any condition stipulated in this Article may be waived by the Minister.

Article Two

A new Article 5(bis) shall be added to Ministerial Decision No. 64 of 2025, as follows:

Article 5(bis) – Experience Requirements

1. For the purposes of Paragraph (b) of Clause 1 of Article 5 of this Decision, the experience requirement shall be deemed to have been fulfilled where the PSP Product through which the Electronic Invoicing

Services are to be delivered has been in operation for a minimum of (2) two years, and the relevant experience in the operation or management of that PSP Product is held by the Service Provider or by the third party referred to under Clause 2 of Article 5 of this Decision.

2. The experience shall be evidenced by any supporting documents required by the Ministry.

Article Three

Any provision contrary to the provisions of this Decision shall be repealed.

Article Four

This Decision shall be published in the Official Gazette and shall come into force from the day following its publication.
